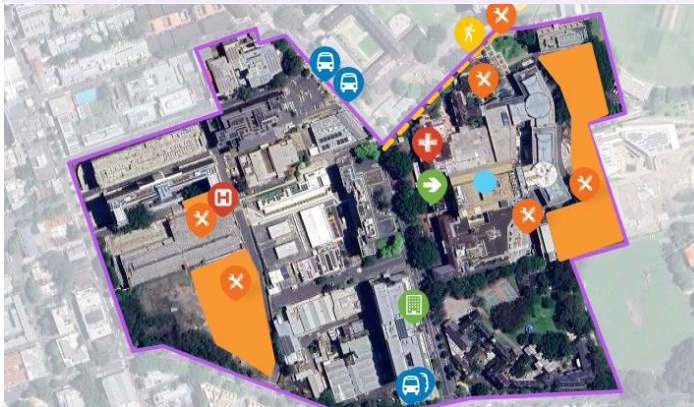


Construction activities March 2024
