Works notice: Wednesday 12 March 2025 RPA Hospital gatekeeper's lodge removal


From Wednesday 12 March to Wednesday 19 March 2025, the RPA Hospital gatekeeper's lodge will be removed.

The gatekeeper's lodge located near the entrance to the Emergency Department ambulance bay is being removed as part of RPA Redevelopment works. This will enable the future expansion of the Emergency Department ambulance bay.

An exclusion zone will be established around the perimeter of the work zone and emergency vehicle access to the hospital will be maintained while the demolition is underway.

Works will involve asbestos removal, which will be completed by qualified asbestos removal professionals. For the safety of staff, patients and visitors, an exclusion zone will be in place around the removal works. The gatekeeper's lodge and electric boom gates were erected in 1962 at the RPA Hospital entrance. The gates were manned 24 hours a day and it was the gatekeeper's responsibility to assist with traffic control and security.
