

## Works notice: Wednesday 15 November 2023 Grose Street and adjacent car park changes

From Wednesday 15 November 2023 between the hours of 7am and 5pm, there will be works occurring in the car park adjacent to the Queen Mary building that will result in a loss of car spaces.

Our contractors are progressing works to set up site for the commencement of the temporary helicopter landing site works. On **Saturday 18 November** our contractors will be removing a light pole. You will notice an increase of construction traffic and traffic controllers in place to help people navigate the area. On **Friday 24 November** there will be a full road closure of Grose Street while a crane is used to unload construction material. Pedestrians are advised that access to the Queen Mary Building via Grose Street will also be closed on this day.

These works will allow the installation of key equipment and cabling required for the temporary helipad operations. There will be temporary removal of 46 car spaces on Level 1 and Level 2 of the staff and visitor carpark adjacent to Grose Street for a period of approximately three weeks. Eight car spaces on Level 1 and two car spaces on Level 2 will be permanently removed while the temporary helicopter landing site is in use. To maximise car spaces, access to the car park and other levels will be maintained.

These works are part of the construction of the temporary helicopter landing site, which will take a period of 12 months to complete. Once complete, the temporary helicopter landing site will be in use for a period of approximately 24 months. ### Key impacts

- Removal of light pole on Grose Street on Saturday 18 November
- Grose Street complete closure on Friday 24 November
- No access to Queen Mary Building via Grose Street on Friday 24 November
- 46 car spaces removed in the visitor and staff car park for three weeks
- 10 car spaces removed in the visitor and staff car park for the duration of temporary helipad operations
- Access to Grose Street via Church Street only
- Three-point turn implemented on Grose Street
