

Works notice: Friday 27 October 2023

Grose street and car parking changes

Commencing Friday 27 October 2023 between 7am to 4pm weekdays, there will be construction activities on Grose Street and in the adjacent staff and visitor car park while our contractors prepare for works to commence on the temporary helicopter landing site.

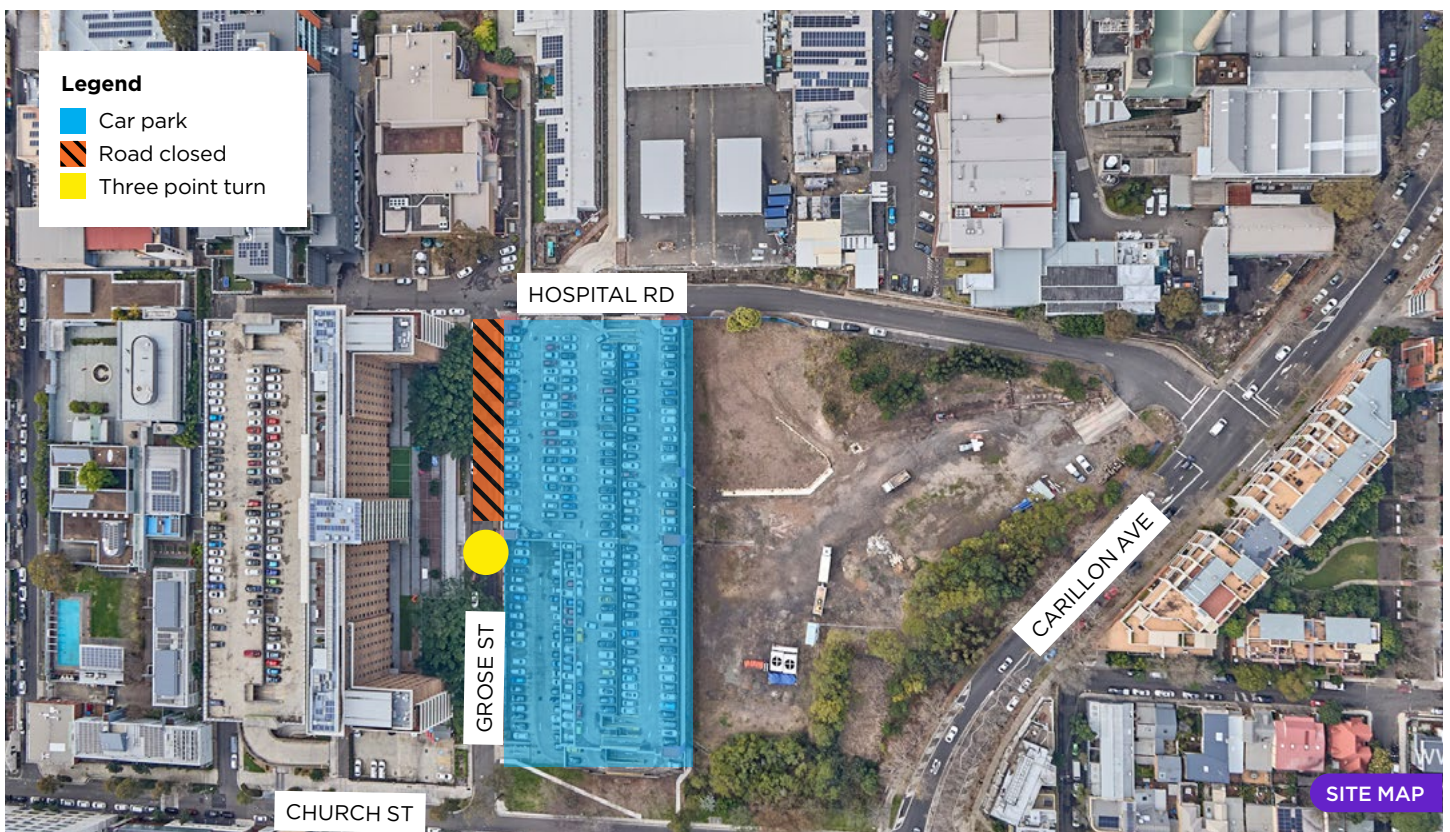
Grose Street access will be via Church Street only, with a 3-point turn installed for car and small vehicle use only. Trucks and larger construction vehicles will need to use an alternate route. These changes will be in place for the duration of works scheduled to continue until approximately late 2024.

Hoarding and temporary lighting will be installed along the Grose Street footpath to ensure pedestrian safety, with access to the disabled ramp maintained at all times.

These activities will require the temporary closure of additional car spaces on level 2 and level 3 in the adjacent car park for a period of one to two weeks. To maximise car spaces, access to the car park will be maintained.

You may notice an increase of construction traffic along Hospital Road and Church Street during the delivery of construction materials. Traffic control will be in place to help people navigate the space, with adjusted road and street signage installed in the area.

These works are part of the construction of the temporary helicopter landing site, which will take a period of 12 months to complete. Once complete, the temporary helicopter landing site will be in use for a period of approximately 24 months. - Increase of construction traffic on Hospital Road and Church Street.
