

Works notice: Wednesday 15 November 2023 Johns Hopkins Drive and Kerry Packer Education Centre

From Wednesday 15 November 2023 between the hours of 7am and 5pm, site establishment works are commencing near the Kerry Packer Education Centre (KPEC) on Johns Hopkins Drive.

These works will take approximately 3 weeks and will include the installation of construction fencing and some tree pruning and removal. The pedestrian footpath to the Kerry Packer Education Centre will be reduced but maintained the majority of the time. Full closure of the footpath is required for one day only while our builders excavate and install necessary pipework.

Works will also commence on the cultural garden near Women and Babies. In consultation with Aboriginal staff and community stakeholders, plans are in place for a reimagined cultural garden that will include generous new trees and plantings.

A traffic control plan has been developed and there will be traffic controllers in place to help pedestrians and vehicles navigate the space.

Changes to pedestrian access

Major works to prepare the site for the future 15-storey hospital building have started on Lambie Dew Drive and Johns Hopkins Drive. Changes to pedestrian access between key buildings within the RPA health precinct are required to ensure everyone's safety. Pedestrians are advised that the best access from RPA Hospital through to Sydney University is via the footpath on Johns Hopkins Drive.
