

# Royal Prince Alfred HOSPITAL REDEVELOPMENT

## **Construction Communications January 2024**

The NSW Government's \$940 million investment in the redevelopment of Royal Prince Alfred Hospital will be the biggest transformation of RPA in the hospital's 140-year history of caring for the community.

Key construction activities this month include the eastern campus site establishment on Lambie Dew Drive and preparing for the temporary helicopter landing site near Grose Street. Current work will be between the standard work hours of 7am to 5pm.
