## **Construction Activities February 2024**

The NSW Government's \$940 million investment in the redevelopment of Royal Prince Alfred Hospital will be the biggest transformation of RPA in the hospital's 140-year history of caring for the community.

Key construction activities this month include road works on Johns Hopkins Drive, construction activities on Gloucester House Drive and works commencing on the women and babies entrance (the new northern arrival).
