

Construction Communications November 2023

The NSW Government's \$940 million investment into the redevelopment of Royal Prince Alfred Hospital will see the biggest transformation of RPA in its 140-year history of caring for the community.

Key construction activities this month include the Eastern campus site establishment on Lambie Dew Drive and preparing for the temporary helicopter landing site near Grose Street. Current work will be between the standard work hours of 7am to 5pm.
