Construction Update

We have experienced heavy rainfall in the past week, with a forecast of more to come. This wet weather has impacted some activities on site. Where possible, main construction activities continue for the new 15-storey East Tower, including excavation, piling and in-ground service installation, along with structural works such as stairwells and lift shafts. These works support the installation of essential infrastructure for the new hospital, located to the north of the existing hospital.

Within the existing hospital, preliminary activities to connect the existing services and infrastructure to the future East Tower are under way. To support these works, activities such as noise testing have been occurring during May. The project team is also progressing detailed planning with hospital staff and stakeholders to finalise the building's interior design, architecture, and service elements.

Pedestrian access changes Works notice	Works are underway and are expected to be completed by mid-June 2025	East campus	Works along the eastern footpath of Missenden Road to support in-ground infrastructure installation for the new hospital continue. Temporary barricades and exclusion zones remain in place to support these activities, with pedestrians intermittently redirected to the western footpath.	
Level 4 corridor works	Works are expected to commence from 27 May 2025	Level 4, Building 89	To support ongoing construction activities, temporary construction zones with barricades and hoarding are being established across the hospital campus.	

Works	Date	Location	Impacts
Central courtyard closure Works notice	Temporary closure to be in place from 27 May 2025.	Central courtyard	The hospital's central courtyard will be temporarily closed to enable construction works connecting to internal areas. As part of these works, the project will deliver a complete courtyard renovation, improving access to the new East Tower, enhancing garden spaces and seating options.
Women & Babies Ambulatory Care construction activities Works notice	Works are expected to commence 29 May 2025.	Women & Babies Ambulatory Care, Level 5	From mid-June, works are scheduled to temporarily relocate the reception area for the Women & Babies Ambulatory Care clinic areas on Level 5 of the RPA Hospital main building. Signage will be in place to help ensure a smooth transition for patients and visitors, and impacted stakeholders will be notified in advance. These works will enable a new connection to be built from Level 5 through to the future East Tower.
Level 3 and 4 façade demolition	Works are expected to commence June 2025	Main Hospital, Building 89	Demolition works are scheduled to take place on the Level 3 and Level 4 façade of the existing hospital, between 7am and 2pm on weekdays. Localised noise and vibration impacts are expected throughout the works. These works are required to enable the future East Tower to connect to the existing hospital.
Piling works Works notice	Ongoing	Lambie Dew Drive and Johns Hopkins Drive	Piling works commenced for eastern extension located west of the Susan Wakil Building. Intermittent noise and vibration from piling work.
Asbestos removal Fact sheet	Ongoing	Lambie Dew Drive	Asbestos removal inside established construction site. Qualified asbestos removal workers in Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) will complete the works. Air monitoring and reporting in place.

Minimising construction impacts

We are committed to minimising the impact of our works. All construction activities are carried out with the health and safety of the local community and site workers as our top priority, and we endeavour to keep noise, dust and vibration to a minimum.

Where possible, activities are scheduled during standard site hours of **Monday to Friday**, **7am to 6pm and Saturday**, **8am to 5pm.** In some areas, works may extend beyond these hours, including occasional 24 hour operations, to support essential services or reduce disruption to hospital activities.

Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.
