

Works notice: Friday 24 May 2024 Lambie Dew Drive tree removal

From 8am on Friday 24 May to 1pm Saturday 25 May 2024, there will be tree removal work taking place inside the construction site on Lambie Dew Drive near the boundary of RPA Hospital campus and Sydney University.

As a precautionary measure the Sydney University Sports and Fitness storage shed will be closed on Friday 24 May while these works take place.


There is no pedestrian access on Lambie Dew Drive and best access between RPA Hospital and Sydney University is via Johns Hopkins Drive.

Access to the RPA Hospital loading dock is via Gloucester House Drive only. Some loading dock bays may be impacted for brief periods while branch cutting takes place. There will be traffic control on site to help people navigate the space during the intermittent road closures.

The construction activities may produce some noise and dust. The ongoing noise and air monitoring will be utilised in this area to minimise impacts.

Key impacts

- Tree removal on Lambie Dew Drive
- No pedestrian access on Lambie Dew Drive
- Loading dock bays impacted for brief periods
- Dedicated traffic controllers to support intermittent road closures
- Possible noise and dust
- Increase of construction works and traffic in this area
