

Works notice: 29 May 2025 Royal Prince Alfred Hospital Redevelopment

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Construction activities – Women and Babies Ambulatory Care, Level 5

From **Thursday 29 May 2025**, construction activities will take place near the Women and Babies Ambulatory Care clinic areas on Level 5 of the Royal Prince Alfred (RPA) Hospital main building, as part of the redevelopment. These works are required to reconfigure some of the area to support the future pedestrian route into the central courtyard and through to the new East Tower.

Works will take place between 7am and 5pm weekdays over an eight-week period from Thursday 29 May 2025. All activities will be carried out with health and safety as our priority.

Activities will include the temporary relocation of the reception area, adjustments to the waiting area and seating, establishment of construction zones with hoarding, and demolition and upgrade of staff stations.

Key impacts

Reception relocation

The reception desk will temporarily relocate to an adjacent area, with signage in place to direct patients and visitors. All entrances will remain accessible to ensure safe and easy movement.

Waiting area

During the works, the waiting area will be adjusted to maintain access and patient flow, with some seating temporarily moved to a nearby room.

Staff areas

Staff areas will be temporarily relocated during construction and existing stations will be upgraded or replaced with modern facilities.

Some noise and vibration impacts are expected during the construction works. Mitigation measures will be in place to minimise any impacts as much as possible, including:

- use of equipment designed to reduce noise and vibration
- sealed perimeter hoarding to contain noise and dust
- · sticky mats to minimise dust spread
- installation of dust monitoring equipment.

During these works, public and staff lifts will be intermittently used by construction workers.
