28 April 2025

Missenden Road footpath closure, starting Monday 28 April 2025

Construction works along the Missenden Road footpath are scheduled to recommence on Monday 28 April 2025. A section of the Missenden Road pedestrian footpath outside the RPA Hospital Emergency Department drop-off area will be closed for approximately six weeks. This is to enable the installation of in-ground infrastructure at the new northern entry to the hospital. There will be detours in place to help pedestrians safely navigate around the works.

An exclusion zone will be established around the perimeter of the work zone and emergency vehicle access will be maintained.

During this time, temporary pedestrian diversions will be in place along the Missenden Road footpath, near the Emergency Department drop-off area. Access will be marked with signs and traffic controllers will be in place to help navigate the space.
