Works notice: Gloucester House Drive

Staff and patients may notice works taking place near Gloucester House Drive and the southern entrance to prepare for the closure of the Women and Babies entrance in April 2024.

From Thursday 8 February 2024,

construction activities will increase on Gloucester House Drive forecourt. These will include the removal of a traffic island, construction of a pedestrian awning and the reconfiguration of parking bays, including pedestrian crossing and line markings.

It is expected that the works will cause some noise and vibration. Our contractors will complete noisy works in intermittent timeframes and use hand tools where possible. We will continue to work to ensure all disruptions are minimised as much as possible.

These works will prepare for the temporary closure of the Women and Babies entrance in mid-April 2024. The Women and Babies entrance is being rebuilt as part of the RPA Hospital Redevelopment and will be the future northern arrival.

Best access to The Perioperative Unit, ICU and Gloucester House

A small drop-off zone has been maintained on Gloucester House Drive for people with mobility issues. With construction increasing across the campus, patients, visitors and staff are advised to use the Level 5 Missenden Road drop-off zone and enter via the main hospital foyer when possible.


Key impacts

- Traffic flow along Gloucester House Drive and through the forecourt will be reduced, with one lane retained for access
- Increase of noise from works occurring near Gloucester House
- Increase of construction traffic on Gloucester House Drive
