

# RPA Hospital Redevelopment

## Construction update 21 March 2025

Work is progressing on the east campus to ready the site for the future 15-storey hospital building located on Lambie Dew Drive.

Johns Hopkins Drive reopened on Friday 21 March 2025. Vehicle access to Centenary Institute, Kerry Packer Education Centre and Molecular Imaging is via Johns Hopkins Drive only, once reopened.

RPA Hospital loading dock access will remain via Gloucester House Drive and there will be no through road to Johns Hopkins Drive via Lambie Dew Drive.

Inside the hospital, demolition and refurbishment work continues as we reconfigure spaces for the future east expansion. There will be upcoming works in the corridor and atrium space on Level 4 and we will provide relevant plans once the works have been confirmed.
