

Works notice: Tuesday 28 May 2024

Johns Hopkins Drive road widening works

Road widening works on Johns Hopkins Drive to create a pedestrian construction safety barrier are expected to commence Tuesday 28 May 2024 for approximately four weeks.

A small section of the road at times will be single-lane only and traffic controllers will be on site to help people navigate the space.

The works involve the installation of new concrete jersey kerbs, speed humps, signage and pedestrian safety barriers. Rectification works will also occur on a small section of the footpath outside the Kerry Packer Education Centre (KPEC). Pedestrian access and the KPEC emergency egress is maintained at all times.

- Footpath rectification works outside KPEC
- New jersey kerbs and speed humps installed
- Traffic control in place
