## Construction update 24 February 2025

Exciting things are happening on the RPA Hospital redevelopment. Work is well under way on the east campus as we get ready to build the state-of-the-art 15-storey hospital building.

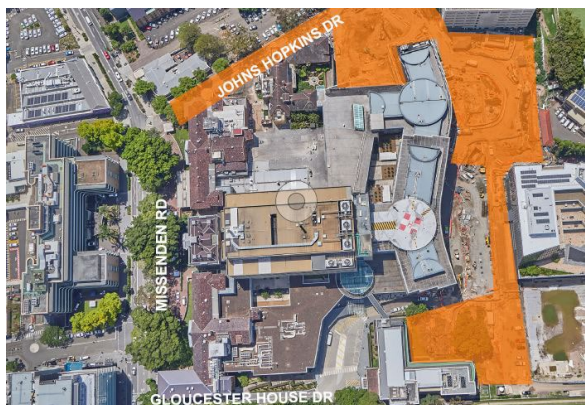
Our first tower crane has officially arrived at site on Lambie Dew Drive and we're gearing up to add a second crane near Johns Hopkins Drive in mid-2025. We're inviting the community to get creative and name the cranes that will be doing some of the heavy lifting over the next two years. Check out the competition details on the [project website](#).

A road closure on Johns Hopkins Drive is expected to commence on Tuesday 25 February 2025 and will extend to the Missenden Road intersection for approximately four weeks. Access to the RPA Hospital loading dock, Centenary Institute, Molecular Imaging and Charles Perkins Centre will be via Gloucester House Drive for authorised vehicles only.

Inside the hospital, demolition and refurbishment work continue as we reconfigure spaces for the future east expansion. There will be upcoming works in the corridor and atrium space on Level 4 and we will let you know about the plans once the works have been confirmed.
