Works notice: Monday 24 March 2025

Vehicle and footpath access changes

From Monday 24 March 2025, Johns Hopkins Drive will be reopened, and a small section of Missenden Road footpath will be closed for approximately six weeks.

Johns Hopkins Drive reopening to vehicles and Missenden Road footpath closure

From Friday 21 March 2025, Johns Hopkins Drive will be reopened to vehicles, following completion of construction works on the road.

From Monday 24 March a section of the Missenden Road pedestrian footpath outside the Emergency Department drop-off area will be closed for approximately six weeks. This is to enable the installation of in-ground infrastructure for the new hospital. There will be detours in place to help pedestrians safely navigate around the works.

Lambie Dew Drive closure

From Friday 21 March 2025, part of Lambie Dew Drive will be closed to enable the construction of the future 15-storey hospital building. Through access between Johns Hopkins Drive and Gloucester House Drive will not be possible. This will be in place for approximately two years until the new hospital building is complete.

Vehicle access changes

Johns Hopkins Drive access:

- Emergency Department
- Molecular Imaging
- Kerry Packer Education Centre
- Charles Perkins Centre gas compound
- Centenary Institute

Gloucester House Drive access:

- RPA Hospital main loading dock
- Level 1 access driveway (including mortuary)
- Gloucester House forecourt (urgent maternity drop-off only)
