Works notice: Monday 3 June 2024 Staff and visitor car park reduced parking

From Monday 3 June to Wednesday 5 June 2024, 250 car spaces will be unavailable on levels 4B and 5 of the staff and visitor car park located on Grose Street. There will continue to be car spaces closed on Level 4B following these works for approximately four weeks.

A crane will be set up in the construction site adjacent to the car park to support the delivery of materials required for the temporary helicopter landing site. Traffic control and signage will be in place to help people navigate the space.

To maximise car spaces, access to the car park will be maintained and our contractors will complete the required works in the below stages:

- 250 car spaces unavailable on levels 4B and 5 from Monday 3 June to Wednesday 5 June (inclusive)
- 65 car spaces closed on Level 4B from Thursday 6 June to Monday 24 June (inclusive)
- 38 car spaces closed on Level 4B from Tuesday 25 June to Tuesday 9 July (inclusive)

This car park will continue to be impacted by the construction and future operation of the temporary helicopter landing site. It is recommended to use alternative travel and parking arrangements where possible.
