

Works notice: Lambie Dew Drive single-lane road closure for construction site and tree removal works

From 7am on Thursday 29 February to 6pm Thursday 14 March 2024 there will be a single-lane road closure and an increase of construction activities on Lambie Dew Drive

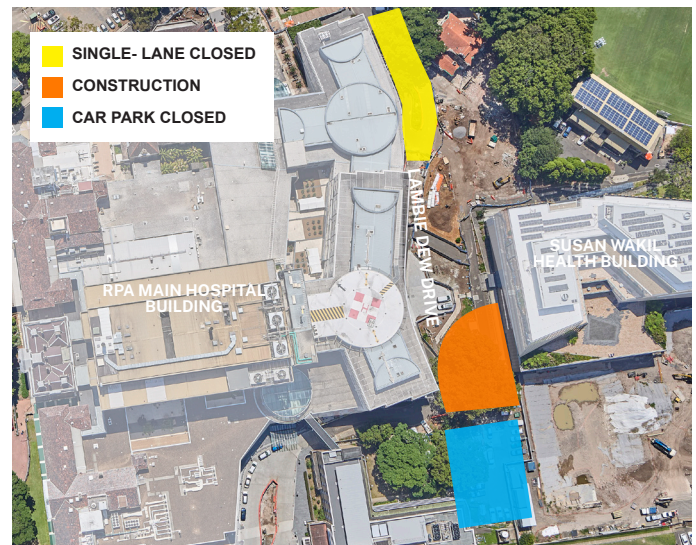
Works will include trenching, construction site decommissioning and tree removal and may cause noise, dust and vibration. Ongoing noise, air and vibration monitoring will be utilised in this area to minimise impacts where possible.

Access to the loading dock will be via Gloucester House Drive and will be limited during off-peak times. There will be dedicated traffic controllers in place to assist pedestrians and vehicles in the safe navigation of the space. It is recommended that pedestrians avoid Lambie Dew Drive where possible, given the increased construction activity.

The car park behind Gloucester House will be closed from Monday 4 March to Saturday 9 March and the Atrium Café balcony on level 4 of the main hospital building will be closed on Wednesday 6 March to Saturday 9 March 2024 while the tree removal works occur.

Key impacts

- Car park behind Gloucester House closed from 4 March to 9 March 2024
- Closure of the Atrium Café balcony on 6 March to 9 March 2024
- Single-lane road closure on Lambie Dew Drive
- Construction site and tree removal
- Increase of construction works and traffic
- Access to the loading dock via Gloucester House Drive only
- Possible noise, dust and vibration
- Dedicated traffic controllers in place



Changes to pedestrian access

Major works to prepare the site for the future 15-storey hospital building have commenced on Lambie Dew Drive and Johns Hopkins Drive. Changes to pedestrian access between key buildings within the RPA health precinct are required to ensure everyone's safety. There is no pedestrian access on Lambie Dew Drive, with pedestrian access between RPA Hospital campus and Sydney University via the footpath on Johns Hopkins Drive.
